## Behaviour Principles:

The Governing Body of the school has laid out for the Headteacher and staff of the school the following general principles which are designed to inform the Attitude to Learning Behaviour Policy. These principles are that all students, staff, parents, governors, and other members of the Benton Park School community will adhere to the following:

- Be courteous and respectful to each other
- Fully support the Attitude to Learning Behaviour Policy at all times
- Deal with Attitude to Learning expectations and any behaviour incidents in a consistent and fair manner
- Be committed to supporting a positive Attitude to Learning for all our students and to developing positive relationships with students. To ensure student outcomes are maximised - this is a particularly relevant and key action for members of school staff to adhere to.

Our Attitude to Learning Behaviour Policy is revisited half termly with students and staff, and termly with parents. It is also available on our school website for other members of the school community to access at any time. This ensures clarity of understanding of our expectations and the application of these across the school. Key messages and reminders are included in the Attitude to Learning Focus which is sent to staff in the Weekly Bulletin. Attitude to Learning is displayed in all classrooms and offices across school, as well as in student planners.
