16-19 Tuition Fund - Statement of Allocation

Statement on the use of the 16-19 tuition fund as required by the ESFA – detailed in their document 16-19 tuition fund released in August 2020.

We are publishing this statement to explain how we will use this funding in line with the guidance to prioritise support for disadvantaged students at Benton Park School. Where subsequent ESFA guidance changes, this statement may be updated to reflect any such change.

This statement demonstrates how the additional funding of £5,140 for 16 to 19-year old students (called the '16 to 19 tuition fund') will be utilised in the 2020-21 funding year.

The additional funding made available to the school will be used to provide:

- Small group tuition in English and Maths for those students who did not achieve a Grade 4 at GCSE. Group size will be no more than 5 students
- 1:1 tuition in English GCSE to support an improvement to at least a GCSE Grade 4
- Resources, including textbooks and revision guides, in English and Maths to support preparation for GCSE examinations
- Individual support for A Level students where learning has been disrupted because of lockdown
- Extra support in vocational courses where learning has been disrupted, for example, where assessment has been deferred and/or otherwise disrupted because of lockdown.

Eligible students will be those identified by the Government as disadvantaged, meaning those who had not achieved a Grade 4 or above in English or Maths by 16 years of age. All eligible students will be on a 16 to 19 study programme.
