Change to Guidance for Key Worker Children

Since the start of the lockdown, Benton Park has remained open to those students who have parents who are critical workers.

The [latest government guidance](#) for the children of critical workers states many parents working in these sectors may be able to look after their child at home, but attendance at school is strongly encouraged. Clearly, this is a change of approach by the government and we know that they are planning to review this on 28th May to ensure that their '5 key tests' are met. If at this point, the evidence calls for a change of position on this we will contact you further.
