WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Component 1: Study of Religion

The religion studied is Judaism and focuses on core Jewish beliefs and practices and social and historical developments, such as Holocaust Theology and gender equality.

Component 2: Philosophy of religion

The philosophical topics studied are: arguments for the existence of God; challenges to religious belief; religious experience and religious language.

Component 3: Religion and Ethics

Topics studied include ethical thought; free will and determinism; and deontological and teleological ethics applied to issues including abortion, euthanasia, polyamorous relationships and nuclear weapons.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

100% Examination

There will be a 2 hour exam for each component, each with equal weighting.

MINIMUM GCSE REQUIREMENTS

- English grade 5
- RE grade 5
