Dear Parents & Carers,

Year 13 Results Day – Thursday 13th August 2020

As we approach the end of a very strange academic year we now look to how we will support our Year 13 students with their next steps. Responses to the survey asking for views on how the results day should be structured have indicated that the majority of students want to attend school to receive their results. We are also in a position to offer an electronic distribution service to those students that wish to receive their results this way.

We are very much looking forward to welcoming our students onto the school site to celebrate their onward destinations. We will be following government guidance regarding safety measures to ensure the protection of students and staff in attendance. In order to do this in a controlled and socially distanced way we will be issuing appointment slots from 8.00am. This will allow us to support students and offer guidance as soon as the UCAS service is open. Students will be able to collect their results and then meet with family members and members of staff outside the results hall.

For those students that need further support with follow up UCAS applications the Sixth Form team will be on hand in the school hall to guide individuals through this process. There will also be the opportunity to receive wider careers guidance on other 'next-steps' options. If your child chooses to have their results sent electronically they will also be able to access support in this way, or by emailing a member of the Sixth Form team.

Appointment slots will be emailed to your child this week. If your child would like to receive their results electronically, please ensure they complete the survey below.
