Turning to our Enterprise Fair, this promises to be a fantastic conclusion to our 2022 Charity Challenge and a celebration of everything we have achieved. It is also aimed at raising lots of money for our chosen school charity as detailed above.

Every Form group is currently busy finalising plans for their Enterprise stall, which has been fully designed and implemented by them and for which they will be responsible for running on the day. In addition to this, all the students will have the opportunity to explore the Fair and join in with the vast array of activities, challenges and events that have been planned.

On the day students are invited to come to school in non-uniform and they will all receive 10 tokens which they can use at the Fair to enjoy the activities.
