## READ

## WRITE

- Explore a range of different beliefs, values and opinions, including their own thoughts and ideas.
- Make judgements on topical issues whilst using key terminology.
- Use factual knowledge to answer questions based on religious identity.
- Critically evaluate concepts relating to religion and ethical themes, making valued judgements and arguments.
- Create essays based on critical evaluation and in-depth knowledge.
- Synthesise difficult concepts into coherent, organised ideas.
- Refer to religious authorities and scholarly opinion.
