





Morning Meetings

Morning meetings provide regular enhancement and revision sessions for Year 11 students, in **Maths, English and Science**. We take the opportunity to:

- Share year group notices and uniform/equipment checks take place during these sessions. The Key Stage leader and SLT link are in attendance every day to support pastoral welfare.
- Share student successes and rewards.
- Give students personalised support with their studies.



Alongside morning meetings, we will be offering a package of enhancement, designed to support students with their **revision** and **knowledge retention** across **all subjects**.

These sessions will **support** students with their **NEA** (non-examined assessment / coursework), **revision techniques** and strategies, and focused **support on specific content areas** within each subject



At the end of the school day, Year 11 students will meet in the main hall for refreshments, listen to some key messages, before attending additional enhancement sessions.

We will be designing a programme that will **guide students** to specific subjects at key times, as well as offering students the **flexibility** to choose the subjects they feel they need the most support with.

It is vital that Year 11 students understand that all timetabled lessons are the number 1 priority. Attendance and engagement at school every day is the <u>best</u> way to secure target grades.

Enhancement sessions are not designed to teach students new content, but to help with **knowledge retention**, **coping with exam pressures**, and to offer students the chance to **practise** their skills.



These sessions will begin after the first internal assessments have finished.

We will analyse the results and support students in making the right choices when deciding on which enhancement sessions to attend.

As English, Maths and Science have regular time in weekly morning meetings, these subjects will not feature as much in the enhancement sessions.
